Workshop Description:

Teachers will attend four different 90-minute sessions during this one-day workshop designed to help them gain new strategies for teaching in a technology rich environment. Sessions include:

- Teaching Tips and Strategies;
- Classroom Culture: setting procedures for success;
- Classroom Technology Expectations and Rules; and
- Increasing Rigor and Engagement.

Teachers will receive a thumb drive containing session materials.

Outcomes:

Teachers will gain new strategies for teaching in a technology rich environment as they consider how to:

- 1) Create effective seating arrangements and room organization ideal for technology implementation
- 2) Use timers to foster success
- 3) Partner effectively with parents :
 - a) communication strategies
 - b) laws regarding student safety online
- 4) Increase rigor and engagement in (one-to-one technology) instruction through:
 - a) creating projects
 - b) managing roles in projects
 - c) developing organization of creation of projects
 - d) managing expectations
 - e) choosing the most effective tools
- 5) Creating effective classroom rules related to technology:
 - a) What's the most important rule(s)
 - b) Caring for a device
 - c) Battery life management
- 6) Implement procedures related to technology:
 - a) How to charge devices
 - b) How to turn in work
 - c) Getting student attention
 - d) Bell Ringers
 - e) Printing
