ICI member and Indiana public institutions will provide teachers learning opportunities to boost STEM instruction in grades K-12 and increase the number of dual-credit teachers of science, technology, engineering and mathematics in Indiana. STEM Teach IV's priority will continue to be graduate level STEM courses for high school teachers working to meet Higher Learning Commission (HLC) dual credit requirements by 2023.

- Graduate courses in content areas such as biology, chemistry, physics, psychology, mathematics, and technology for teachers pursuing dual credit teaching credentials
- Graduate and undergraduate courses for K-12 teachers
- Scholarships to STEM conferences in Indiana or STEM classroom kits

- Opportunities in online, face-to-face or hybrid formats as allowed
- Six semesters of offerings: Spring 2020, Summer I 2020, Summer II 2020, Fall 2020, Spring 2021 and Summer I 2021
